

# **READY. SET. GO!**

Learn how you can prepare your family and home before an emergency. Taking action now can help you evacuate quickly before the threat reaches your doorstep.

## READY- Prepare Now BE AWARE OF DANGER IN THE AREA

- √Connect with your Emergency
- Management/Sheriff's Office on social media.
- √Make a family communication plan that includes family phone numbers, out-of-town contacts and family meeting locations.
- ✓Assemble an emergency supplies kit (Go Kit). Start with the five P's.
- √Check with your neighbors, family, friends, and elders to ensure they are READY.
- √Keep up to date on local news, weather watches and warnings.

#### SET - Be Alert

#### SIGNIFICANT DANGER IN THE AREA

- ✓Residents should consider voluntarily relocating to a shelter or with family/friends outside the affected area.
  ✓Grab your emergency supplies kit.
- ✓Keep in mind unique needs for your family or special equipment for pets and livestock.
- ✓Stay aware of the latest news and information from public safety officials.
- X This might be the only notice you receive. Emergency services cannot guarantee they will be able to notify everyone if conditions rapidly deteriorate. Be SET to GO!

### GO! - Evacuate

#### DANGER IS IMMINENT

- ✓Residents should evacuate immediately to a shelter or with family/friends outside of the affected area.
- ✓If you choose to ignore this advisement, you must understand emergency services may not be able to assist you further.
- ✓ Follow instructions from emergency personnel, stay on designated evacuation routes and avoid closed areas.



## Step 1: Visit protect.genasys.com

**Find your zone:** type your address in the search bar or use your current location.



**Record** your zone and store it in a visible location inside your home.



During the next emergency, residents may be asked to evacuate or shelter in place. These orders will be given by utilizing pre-determined zones. Know your zone and be ready.
